#### **Ryan L'Abbé: Vice President & General Manager, Ice River Springs - Blue Mountain Plastics Division**

Ryan joined Ice River Springs in 2007 as Plant Manager in Feversham, Ontario. As Vice President - Human Resources, he led the company's expansion into four new plant locations in Canada and the US. He now leads Blue Mountain Plastics Inc. - the company's division responsible for the purchasing and processing of recycled PET from the Blue Box Program and the manufacture of 100% recycled PET bottles. Ryan holds Bachelor of Commerce and Master of Industrial Relations Degrees from Queen's University, as well as certificates from the University of Wisconsin (Packaging Technology) and Harvard University.

#### **Pushkar Kumar: CEO, GreenMantra Technologies**

Pushkar has extensive management experience building companies across multiple geographies. He has grown the business of a large technology company, both through strategic acquisitions and direct sales. As a sales manager, he was directly responsible for sales of services worth over \$15M, and managing a delivery team of over 150 people. He was also a founding member of Agere India, where he was instrumental in the company's initial growth and success. He has an MBA from Richard Ivey School of Business (Canada) and is also a Metallurgical Engineer (Indian Institute of Technology, Roorkee, India).

#### **Amit Golan: Vice President Manufacturing Technologies, Gracious Living**

Amit is a valuable member of Gracious Living's Senior Management team.
